This role supports the planning and execution of our visual arts programming, but, at Real Art Ways, responsibilities often overlap so flexibility and a team-first mindset go a long way. Day-to-day, you can expect to:

- Handle scheduling and logistics for visual arts programming
- Communicate and coordinate with artists, curators, and collaborators
- Maintain and update artist files, exhibition materials, and archives
- Research artists, exhibitions, and regional arts events
- Update website content and relevant archival information
- Design layouts for published and printed materials
- Collaborate with the Director of Marketing on communications
- Assist with general administrative tasks as needed
- Manage and organize data of proposals and applications
